Higher-performing building envelopes and higher-performing HVAC and lighting systems are some of the essential components to meet current energy codes. The integration of innovative water efficiency measures, such as storm water management, rainfall capture, treated effluent reuse, roof gardens and other alternative sources of water supply are fully described.
